

I have nothing "presidential" to share with you this month so I will discuss the classes I am offering to teach.

I have decided to offer both Krista Moser pattern classes on 2 different dates. There must be at least 4 people participating or the class will be canceled. If you sign up, you will get a handout PRIOR to class which will explain things and tell you how to prepare for the class. The cost of each class is \$10 plus the cost of the pattern. Both patterns suggest using a ruler that costs \$39. I did purchase the ruler and will share it at both classes. It is also possible to use another large ruler that has the 60 degree line marked. Did you know?

Dr Ruth Benerito, a USDA chemist, helped perfect wrinkle-free cotton fabric. She and her colleagues developed the cross-linking process resulting in cotton fabric requiring little to no ironing. Their breakthrough in the 1960s also contributed to innovations in stain-resistant and flame-retardant cotton. Dr Benerito, who retired from the USDA and taught in Louisiana until age 81, died at age 97. She held more than 50 patents, many of which were in cotton chemistry.
